





#### 1. Gender Champions -18th June 2022

In order to promote gender equality, guaranteed by Article 15 of the Indian Constitution, the University Grants Commission released a notice on the Saksham portal regarding the implementation of Guidelines for Gender Champions in Educational Institutions (DO NO F 91- 2/2014 (GS) dated June 10, 2022 - UGC-notice). The members of IC Committee discussed on the names of numerous students during the year 2021 - 22 depending on the parameters, such as overall performance, in activities on Gender disparities and organizational skills. The guidelines and eligibility requirements were displayed on the Notice board (Staff Common Room & IC Notice board).

**Gender Champions 2021 – 22** 





### 2. Sketching and Face Painting Competition 25th August 2022






### 4. Film screening on "Women's Equality Day"- 29th August 2022

## 5. Debate Competition on 'Corporate Office Culture provides safe work atmosphere for Women'- 22<sup>nd</sup> December 2022

The Internal Committee and Women Development cell in collaboration with Parvaaz organized a debate Competition on the topic 'Corporate Office Culture provides safe work atmosphere for Women' on December 22, 2022 in Room no 34 from 10.00 am to 12.30 pm. The objective was to raise awareness about the benefits and drawbacks of corporate office culture in providing a safe work environment for women and the necessity to provide a safe environment for female employees. 18 students participated in the discussion, with 10 supporting and 8 against the topic. The debate comprised of total four rounds as follows. Round 1 of the competition gave each participant a minute to voice their viewpoint, while round 2 saw each group asking the opposing group challenging questions. In round 3, either group answered questions from the audience. In Round 4, one representative from each group had two minutes to summarize their presentations. The judgement was based on whether the participant's opinions and content were relevant to the theme or not, the presentation or expression of thinking, and counter-questioning when other participants presented their views. The audience had a good time watching the competition. Every debater was cheered and applauded for their engaging presentation and strong arguments.
