RepublicRide – 2021 26 th January 2021		Republic Ride was planned by Sarus Nature Club and IQAC on Republic day for which students were encouraged for the use of bicycle to promote health and environment awareness by participating in Majhi Vasundhara Abhiyan which is an initiative by Government of Maharashtra to sensitize every citizen to Mitigate the effects of Climate Change. These objectives were posted on students groups for circulation and good response was received from the students and teachers of NCC, NSS and Lifelong Learning & Extension Dept. All the cyclist attended the flag hoisting function at 9.00 a.m. in the college premises and after Republic day parade, the teaching and non-teaching staff members actively participated in this cycling activity and everybody present over there, took the E-pledge - 'Cycle for good health and environment, its Economical too. Co. Ltd.	The Department of Economics in collaboration with IQAC, conducted a National Level Webinar on "Mangroves – Distribution, Adaptation and Biodiversity". The resource person threw light on the benefits of mangroves, the area under mangroves conserved by Godrej and Boyce Mfg. Co. Ltd. and the methods to conserve it. He explained the means adopted by the Company to conserve huge acres of land under mangrove biodiversity. He emphasized that conservation initiatives include on site protection of mangrove ecosystem by providing security to the premises, development and management of a mangrove nursery, running regular plantation programmes, development and management of educational infrastructure such as nature trials, theme gardens, a mangrove information centre, a marine aquarium and a watchtower. The session was a beneficial for 163 participants who attended from various renowned colleges from across Mumbai.

Hence, the resource persons of the webinar spoke on women exploitation, representation and misrepresentation of women in spaces like family, society, literature, commercial media and social, cyber and domestic exploitation and crimes and justice against the same. Dr. Vibhuti Patel, former Director Of Women's Studies Centre, TISS and HoD of SNDT University, the keynote speaker of the webinar tracing the history of women's position in India talked on Women's representation in Parliament. The webinar which had an overwhelming response had more than 550 registrations, including both teachers and students. 257 participants (188 female and 69 male) attended the webinar.
