1.	National Level Online E-QUIZ on Environmental Sustainability 5 <sup>th</sup> June 2022		Sarus Nature Club in collaboration with IQAC online National level Quiz Competition on World Environment Day. 5 <sup>th</sup> June 2022. The main objective of the Quiz Competition was to encourage and promote sustainable environmental practice as well as to offer participants with a platform to obtain and explore environmental knowledge. The E-Quiz consisted of 25 MCQs on Environmental Sustainability, with a minimum score of 60% required to receive a digital certificate of excellence, which was mailed to their registered email address. Around 150 participants, comprising faculty and students from various colleges (110 female and 40 male) from Kerala, Karnataka, Maharashtra, and other states, participated and got certificates of excellence, making this event a success.
2.	<b>Paper Bag Day Celebration</b> 12 <sup>th</sup> July 2022 11.30 am to 1.00 pm College Auditorium.		On the occasion of Paper Bag Day, Sarus Nature Club (SNC) and IQAC organized display of paper bags. The Chairperson of SNC emphasized the significance of World Paper Bags Day. Dr. Mahmood Alam, Vice Principal, addressed how we should avoid using plastic and lessen our reliance on paper. The Principal urged everyone present to use paper or cloth bags every day and to avoid using plastic as much as possible. On this occasion, resource persons of World Wetlands Day, Principal Dr. Sirajuddin Chougle and World Wildlife Day, Dr Jayashree Menon were honored with mementos of appreciation. Student volunteers who had actively participated in SNC activities throughout the pandemic period were also felicitated with mementos and certificates.
3.	Orientation Programme for First year classes 11 <sup>th</sup> to 13 <sup>th</sup> August 2022 9.30 am to 12.30 pm CollegeAuditorium	IQAC Team	Orientation programme were conducted for the first-year classes of all faculties in scheduled slots in order to give a brief overview about the Mission, Vision, Code of Conduct, various courses offered by the institution, subject combinations, infrastructure, attendance, discipline, Co-Curricular, Extra Curricular and Extension Activities. Students were made aware about the functioning of Library and other facilities available in the college like Book Bank, Student aid fund, Gymkhana, NCC (Boys & Girls), NSS, Incubation Center etc. Students were also informed about examination – evaluation pattern, tentative exam schedule and University rules and regulations. 396 students attended the orientation program.
4.	Har Ghar Tiranga Mega Awareness Rally 13 <sup>th</sup> August 2022		The NCC and NSS units, in collaboration with IQAC, organized a mega Awareness rally to create awareness of Har Ghar Tiranga initiative of Government of India. The rally was attended by 75 NCC cadets, 25 NSS volunteers, and 15 College staff members, including the supervisor and Principal Sir. The rally began from Maharashtra College and ended at Nagpada Junction. The rally's aim was to encourage people to bring home the Tiranga (Tricolour) and to hoist the national flag to commemorate India's 75th year of independence. The purpose of the campaign is to instill a sense of patriotism in people and raise awareness of the Indian National Flag.

5.	National Conference on 'Commercialization of Education: Impact on Marginalized Sections of Society' 27 <sup>th</sup> & 28 <sup>th</sup> August 2022 College Auditorium	Dr. B. Mungekar, Former VC of University of Mumbai. Dr. M. H. Jawahirullah MLA Tamilnadu Prof. Disha Nawani Center of Education, TISS Dr Zahir Qazi, Chairman Anjuman Islam, Dr Ranu Jain, TISS Ms Ainul Attar, TISS Dr Abdul Shaban, TISS. Mr Md Shuaib Khatib, Chairman Juma Masjid Mr Saleem Anware	National Conference on 'Commercialization of Education: Impact on Marginalized Sections of Society' was organized with an objective to discuss the impact of commercialization and privatization in education, studying the impact of coaching institutes in the deprivation of marginalized students, formulating a well-informed opinion about equal opportunity for all in education, and analyzing the issues faced by poor students while attempting NEET & JEE exams without being able to acquaint themselves with the issues faced by poor students. The conference was able to hold relevant discussions by presenting research papers on various topics related to commercialization/privatization. The speakers presented an excellent collection of ideas, leaving the audience torn between the benefits and drawbacks of commercialization. The conference benefited 109 participants.
6.	Interactive session with the non-teaching staff 21 <sup>st</sup> September 2022.		The Principal and IQAC held an interactive session with the non-teaching staff to discuss the documentation and accreditation processes. The IQAC team thoroughly discussed the seven criteria and the documentation required for each criterion. The Principal explained the softwares used for various purposes such as admission, examination, attendance etc. and instructed all non-teaching staff to learn how to utilize such softwares. They were also made aware of their responsibilities, rights as well as the importance of discipline.
7.	Intellectual Property Rights Awareness Program 21 <sup>st</sup> September 2022. Hybrid mode	Shree Suman Sil, Examiner of Patents & Designs in Patent Office, Kolkata	The IQAC in association with the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Department for Promotion of Industry & Internal Trade Office of the Controller General of Patents, Designs and Trademarks, Government of India organized Intellectual Property Rights Awareness Program under National Intellectual Property Awareness Mission (NIPAM). The resource person of the program Starting with the history and origin of IPR, he primarily focused on the objectives of IPR towards promoting innovation and creativity, especially amongst entrepreneurs and in higher education institutions, steps to apply for it and the ways of protecting it. The program had a very good response from 130 participants including students and teachers and was strongly supported by the college management. Certificates by the Govt. of India were issued to all the participants
8.	Session on 'Self Purification and Development' 27 <sup>th</sup> September 2022 8.40 am to 10.30 am College Auditorium	Dr. Rakhshandah Hani IQAC Coordinator	The IQAC and the Code of Conduct Monitoring Committee jointly conducted a session on 'Self Purification and Development' to raise awareness of life's virtues among students. The Resource Person Dr. Rakhshandah Hani - IQAC Coordinator and Head, Department of Economics emphasized on the fundamental concepts of self-purification such as having a decent heart, good behaviour, and good intentions,self- discipline, forgiving, giving up undesired urges, self-analysis, and so on. She explained to the pupils that knowledge without education or self- purification is harmful because it fosters ego and arrogance, which can lead to a person seeking the world in a destructive and corrupt manner. Numerous examples were utilized to illustrate to the students the significance of personality development and self-purification. The session was beneficial to 110 (92 female &18 male) students.

9. Workshop on 'Filling CAS forms as per New UGC regulations

Dr Nigvendra Sharma, Head, Department of Physics IQAC conducted a workshop on 'Filling CAS forms as per New UGC regulations (7th Pay)'. 19 teachers of the college are due for placement in the academic year 2022-23. Such a workshop was arranged especially for their benefit, though all teachers were invited to attend. The IQAC Coordinator introduced the purpose of the workshop and the current challenges facing the institution- the long tedious CAS process and the retirement of the College registrar. Dr Nigvendra Sharma, Head, Department of Physics was the resource person who presented the various UGC regulations introduced in March 2019 as per the recommendations of the Seventh Pay Commission. He used a power point presentation for better explanation of the rules. After the presentation, several queries of teachers were solved by the resource person and the IQAC Coordinator. The event was highly appreciated by the teaching faculty. 22 faculty members attended the workshop.

10.	Workshop on" New Education Policy-2020: Implications for The Future" 12 <sup>th</sup> January 2023 8.00 am to 10.00 am College Auditorium	Dr. Vijay Joshi, Chief Consultant, RUSA,	The workshop was conducted by the IQAC, Maharashtra College to understand the exact structure of NEP-2020 and the preparedness of the college for the NEP. Dr. Vijay Joshi, the resource person discussed the gaps in the present education system and how NEP would assist to generate more skilled students who will be ready to become entrepreneurs or job-ready immediately. He primarily focused on the structural changes that will occur following the implementation of the NEP, particularly in academics and administration. Furthermore, he offered a clear insight into what essential improvements need be made so that they are ready to instantly implement the NEP. The program was attended by 83 participants both degree and junior college teachers.

Chief guest of this camp was Mr.Javed Juneja Corporator BMC who encouraged the college staff and students along with BMC workers to avail the facility of free checkup and cancer screening.Total 110 BMC workers,42 college staff and 62 college students avail this facility
12.	Program for Girl Students on the topics of Legal Awareness Reaching heights of Success Importance of self defence 7 <sup>th</sup> February 2023 9.30 am to 1.00 pm College Auditorium	Advocate Hurya Patel, Mrs Munira Gigani Ms.Gazala Aazad	The IQAC, Women Development Cell and Internal Committee in association with Mumbai Aman Committee - Ladies Wing organized a program for girl students. The speakers for the session Advocate Hurya Patel provided a presentation on easy steps for applying, updating, rectifying, linking and obtaining important documents like PAN Card, Aadhaar Card, Passport, Domicile etc. Mrs Munira Gigani explained to the girls the ways to achieve success through loving and respecting parents, putting in hard effort, and setting objectives and achieving them with sincerity and determination. She gave them advice on how to become a successful person by being passionate and committed to their goals and avoiding distractions. Ms Gazala Aazad discussed the necessity of self-defense and provided some demonstration tips. She mentioned how ladies should be cautious and vigilant while exchanging personal information with friends or on any internet platform. The process was supported by Advocate Nadeem Siddiqui (Document and Scholarship Advisor) and his team. 22 teaching staff, 8 non teaching staff and 16 students were benefitted from camp.
