An Epidemic after Pandemic

Some bitter experiences in the exams in the post-Covid era have thrown up shock and surprise for all of us. We have seen multifold increase in copy cases in the examination and also the blatant use of technology for copying. Not that such malpractices were not used earlier but the number of students using it has increased at an alarming rate this time.

Despite making students aware of the dire consequences, the malpractices refuse to die down. All our warnings are falling on the deaf ears.

We all know that the number of students caught copying is always much lesser than those who actually copy in exam. When such a large number of students go undetected, it would embolden others and we have an apprehension that this number could only go up in future.

The sad part of the story is effrontery of students after they are caught. And one is at his wit's ends to see parents also coming to the

defence of their wards at such occasions.

This phenomenon has been reported across all educational institutions. The current Board Examination has also exposed this occurrence. We believe that it is the offshoot of the pandemic period where students across various levels have been exposed to online examinations which gave them opportunities to indulge in unfair practices without being detected.

Another impact of these online exams is that it has negatively impacted the writing skills of students. They have jettisoned their writing capabilities and now they are finding it difficult to form even small sentences.

This is a dire problem, what is the way out?

The only way to normalize this mess is to spread the awareness among students of the immediate consequences when they are caught copying. We should also make it clear for them the danger of defamation and vilification in the society if they are caught copying.

The teachers must focus on improving the writing skills of their pupils. They need to make students realize that 'Practice makes man perfect' and hone their writing skills as much as possible.

The teachers ought to sensitize them of being fair and also highlight the blot of cheating they will have to carry throughout their life; which will keep pricking their conscience forever.

On the other hand, the teachers will have to be more vigilant during their examination duty as an invigilator. They must not give candidates an opportunity to risk their future by falling prey to the false illusions: they will escape by indulging in the wrong practice easily.

The parents need to tutor their wards about the ethical aspect of indulging in unfair means in the examination. They should make it a

point to keep a close watch and deter their child from any such activity.

We –teachers and parents- must understand that molding the moral values of the child is the utmost responsibility that can't be ignored. Especially, in these post-Covid times.

Come, let us join our hands to root out this epidemic before it turns out to be a pandemic.








Script at Mani Bhavan depicting Mahatma Gandhi's Handwriting





National Conference on "Commercialization of Education: Impact on Marginalized Sections of Society"


Research Academy of Social Science (RASS) in collaboration with Maharashtra College organized a two-day National Conference on "Commercialization of Education: Impact on Marginalized Sections of Society" on 27th and 28th August 2022. The President for the occasion was Dr Zahir Qazi, Chairman Anjuman Islam, Honorable Chief Guest Dr Ranu Jain, TISS, Guest of Honour Ms Ainul Attar and Dr Abdul Shaban, TISS. Mr. Md Shuaib Khatib, Chairman Juma Masjid and Mr. Saleem Anware also graced the occasion to felicitate the students of TYBSc IT, the young developers of the AL-Islaah Live Azan App.



The two-day conference had three technical sessions with twelve paper presenters who used different Research Methodologies both qualitative and quantitative to express their concern over the commercialization of education which could be equated to marketisation of education. Researchers mentioned that, PPP (Public Private Partnership) will be a necessarily evil in the realm of education. The boom in the coaching class culture which could be seen as detrimental to the rural student over the urban student. Every speaker offered a great set of ideas, and left the audience oscillating between the boon and bane of commercialization of education.

The Guest of Honour, MsAinul Attar and Dr Abdul Shaban, both agreed that many of the marginalised children had paid a high price and were on the verge of succumbing to the pressures of commercialization of education. The gap between the haves and have-nots is widening, and the government must bridge it as soon as feasible. Dr. Ranu Jain, Chief Guest, stated that others should recognise that if this division is not addressed, it will worsen, and that people from marginalised groups, as well as the average man, should organise and voice their ideas loudly and clearly. Perhaps this will eliminate the divide, and we can look forward to the "universalization of education." Dr Ranu Jain, Chief Guest asserted that others also should understand that this divide can intensify further if not addressed and people from the marginalized sections as well as the common man should organize and voice their opinions loud and clear. Maybe, this could irradicate this divide and we can hope for the "universalization of education.". The President for the event, Dr Zahir Qazi Chairman Anjuman Islam, citing personal examples talked about how Muslim educational institutions cannot be seen lagging behind but a current census if done, will prove that the minorities too are forging ahead in the realm of education. He applauded the students from Maharashtra College who were bringing laurels to the institution. He also

reiterated the fact that privatisation of education is here to stay, but it is in an institutions hand whether to use it for the benefit of community or use it as a commodity that they need to sell. The program ended with a Vote of thanks by Mr Suhail Shaikh from SIO. He thanked the dignitaries, delegates of the conference, the organizers of the event and the wonderful audience for making the conference a successful one.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) in association with the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Department for Promotion of Industry & Internal Trade Office of the Controller General of Patents, Designs and Trademarks, Government of India organized Intellectual Property Rights Awareness Program under National Intellectual Property Awareness Mission (NIPAM) on September 21, 2022.

Intellectual property rights (IPR) refers to the legal rights given to the inventor or creator to protect his invention or creation for a certain period of time. These legal rights confer an exclusive right to the inventor/creator or his assignee to fully utilize his invention/creation for a given period of time.

Universities and public research institutions are among the direct contributors towards innovation and research, particularly in emerging economies. Off late, the significance of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) in higher education has been widely recognized. The principal of the college Dr. Sirajuddin Chougle











reflected on the significance of universities and public research institutions as direct contributors towards innovation and research, particularly in emerging economies. He further added, the potential pool of talent for innovation in these economies also emanates largely from educational institutions and research institutions; hence, the need of the time is to recognize Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) in higher education.

The resource person of the program was Shree Suman Sil, Examiner of Patents & Designs in Patent Office, Kolkata under Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Govt. of India. Starting with the history and origin of IPR, he primarily focused on the objectives of IPR towards promoting innovation and creativity, especially amongst entrepreneurs and in higher education institutions, steps to apply for it and the ways of protecting it. The program had a very good response from both student and teacher communities and was strongly supported by the college management.

Session on 'Self Purification & Development'

In today's society, it is incredibly challenging to live a virtuous life. Therefore, irrespective of Hinduism, Buddhism, or Islam, Self-Purification and Personality Development have a prominent position in all world faiths. Hence, a session on 'Self Purification and Development' was jointly conducted by the IQAC and Code of Conduct Monitoring Committee on Tuesday, September 27, 2022 at 8.40 am in the College Auditorium. The Resource Person Dr. Rakhshandah Hani - IQAC Coordinator and Head, Department of Economics emphasized on the basic principles of self-purification like having a good heart, good behavior, good intentions Self Discipline, forgiveness, Sacrificing unwanted desires, self analysis



etc. She described to the students how knowledge without education or self-purification is harmful and develops ego and arrogance, which may lead a person to seek the world generally in a destructive and corrupt way. She went on to explain that one of the main benefits of self-purification is that those who practice it experience happiness in this life, before the afterlife. Holding the



soul accountable is the only way to purify and cleanse it as we can identify the flaws and work to correct them. 




