The Women Development Cell and Internal Committee in association with Team Responsible Netism organized a National Level Webinar on ‘Cyber Sakhi’ on 26th July 2021 from 12 to 1.30 pm through Zoom Platform. The Speaker for the Webinar was Ms. Shilpa Chandolika (Trustee – Ahaan Foundation) who is a facilitator and Trainer at Responsible Netism. Prof. Parveen Khan started the Webinar by highlighting the recent trends of Global Pandemic & cybersecurity Statistics that reveal a huge increase in Cyber Crimes especially with respect to Women which is a matter of great concern, hence such webinars are important to create awareness and is need of the hour. Thereafter the Principal, Dr. Sirajuddin Chougale and Vice Principal, Dr Majid Ansari welcomed the speaker and the participants and stressed on the need of such programmes to make digital experience happier, fruitful and safe.

The speaker Ms. Shilpa Chandolika gave an insightful and comprehensive presentation on the types of cybercrimes against women, Cyber Terrorism, Cyber bullies, cyber safety guidelines, responsible online behavior and also discussed various case studies. She provided hints on identifying technical threats and various preventive measures for protection against cybercrimes. A helpline number was also shared to the participants in case of cyber related threats and issues. 




Gender


How was the resource person in terms of providing information on Cyber Safety

Cancer is one of the leading cause of death across the world. A disease that may remain silent before showing its disastrous effects. Detection of the disease at an early stage is the key to have speedy and complete recovery. In order to create awareness among students about Cancer and remove the stigma and fear attached with it, an online talk on ‘Cancer in Women: Fear versus Awareness’ was organised on 10th August 2021 from 4.00 to 5.30 pm through Microsoft Teams Platform. The Guest speaker Ms. Sameena Bilgi, Head, Patient Guidance Program, Gunvati Jagan Nath Kapoor Foundation educated the participants about the signs and symptoms of Breast Cancer, Oral Cancer and Cervical Cancer. She also explained the various risk factors, early detection, diagnosis, and treatment options. The talk was followed by an informative video demonstration for women about mammograms, clinical breast exam, self-breast examination, Pap smear tests to check for signs of cervical cancer. She highlighted on the myths that people wrongly believe and emphasized on the importance of screening for early detection and motivated students to follow a healthy lifestyle. The girls were very happy with the informative session and this was indicated through their positive responses and a very elaborate question answer session. The talk was attended by 165 participants.



Keeping with its mandate, the Commission has, from time to time, taken up various initiatives to progressively increase awareness about the laws in order to generate awareness in the society against various social evils effecting rights of women and on rights and entitlements of women in the society as a whole. The Commission launched an Open Quiz on 'Awareness on Crime against Women' through MyGov Portal.
